Online In-Service Training Seminar on Bullying, Cyberbullying and Gangs

CyberAngels has joined forces with a seasoned provider of quality online in-service training seminars for educators, Monmouth-Ocean Educational Services Commission, <u>www.moesc.org</u>, an agency of the NJ Department of Education, to produce web-based multimedia educational programs on a student safety issues.
